


The Racine County Flag

The new Racine County flag carries deep meaning within the design. The symbolism of each element is drawn out in particular descriptions so that we may understand the thought process and community input that went into each example.

BLOCKS – The feature blocks represent what residents recognize as most precious in our county; Recreation, Agriculture, and Industry. The blocks overlay each other as a symbol of their interdependency, each value building on the other. They impose on each other as a reminder of joint efforts made throughout our neighborhoods for the betterment of all. They are truly the building blocks of our community. They support each other and allow the design to become an implication of forward motion when viewing the lower blocks leading edges. The blocks lay on their points in a geometrical fashion in deference to that principal's use in all industry, as well as in respect to our great architectural legacy.

BANNER – The bands emanating from the three building blocks point in two directions. One reminds us of our past and to always look behind us for guidance while the other points to our future. Neither band reaches fully to the end of the flag thereby indicating room to grow. The bands do not divide the flag, rather they allow for a united purpose. They allow the flag to remain whole, just as our county is one community. They point to openness and increased opportunity. The points of the bands show we are breaking barriers. They indicate constant motion and improvement, as well as continuous evolution as a county.

1836 – Inserting the year of our origin into the design honors the county seal. The placement of the year is at the bottom of the flag. This signifies our beginning, and from that small start our county grew fuller and more prosperous. It is placed in the design in tribute to our past as the root of our heritage and allows the design to grow larger just as our county did.

RACINE COUNTY – Our name conveys bold leadership. It appears proudly as a statement of who we are and is present in reverent support of those whom our county serves.

COLORS – Blue represents our waterways. It fills the entire field and reminds us that our water heritage surrounds us. Recreation is also represented in blue as we are reminded of the many opportunities to interact with our Great Lake, rivers, and inland lakes. The golden tan color represents our connection to the earth through agriculture, as well as our kinship with the land, while reminding us of our attachment to wholesome sustenance, and reverence for where it originates. Gray is used to honor industry and as a symbol of strength.

DESIGN – The design of the flag alludes to a more contemporary attitude toward managing government. It supports the Racine County image and a positive relationship amongst all branches of county government. Similarities to the Wisconsin state flag honor the state which we are a significant part of.
