VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR RACINE COUNTY ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY PROGRAM

Racine – Racine County Executive Jonathan Delagrave announced that the county is again seeking groups to volunteer in Racine County's Adopt-A-Highway Program.

Adopt-A-Highway groups perform clean-up along an approximate two-mile segment of a county highway at least three times a year between April 1 and November 1. Groups are provided with safety vests, bags, and signs. Group members must be at least 11 years old and in the sixth grade.

For performing this work, the sponsoring group receives recognition through the signs that mark the limits of the route and publicize the sponsoring group.
