

NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES POSTING CASH* BOND

Carefully Read Information on this Notice BEFORE Posting Bond Money

- ⇒ ***BOND MONEY POSTED CAN AND WILL BE USED TO PAY ANY OF THE DEFENDANT'S RESTITUTION, FINES, FEES, OR COURT COSTS WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE PER WISCONSIN STATUTES.***
- ⇒ ***CAUTION: BE AWARE OF YOUR PERSONAL EXPOSURE FOR THE FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS OF THE DEFENDANT IN THIS CASE OR OTHERS THAT MAY BE PENDING BEFORE THE COURTS, BEFORE YOU SIGN THIS BOND.***
- ⇒ The person posting money (depositor) must provide their full name, full address and complete telephone number. A photo ID (Driver's License or State ID Card) is required.
- ⇒ If a charge is dismissed or bond is ordered returned, money will be refunded to the person listed as the depositor on the bond receipt per Wisconsin Statute. Keep your copy of the receipt.
- ⇒ Any change of address for the defendant or the person posting money must be submitted in by written, notarized request with a copy of your jail receipt. Requests should be mailed to:

- ⇒ All letters or requests must include the court case number.
- ⇒ If a defendant does not follow all of the Terms and Conditions of bail/bond, as set by the court, the cash posted will be forfeited. Conditions of Bail/Bond Include:
- Defendant shall appear on all court dates.
 - Defendant shall give written notice to the Clerk of Court within 48 hours of any change of address or telephone number.
 - Defendant shall not commit any crime.
 - Defendant shall neither directly, nor indirectly threaten, harass, intimidate or otherwise interfere with victims or witnesses in this action.
 - Defendant shall comply with any other condition as ordered by the court.
- ⇒ The Sheriff's Department will keep a defendant in custody until the defendant has signed the bond, complied with the monetary conditions of release, or is otherwise discharged.
- ⇒ The defendant may be prohibited from possessing, transporting, shipping, receiving, or purchasing a firearm, including, but not limited to, a rifle, shotgun, pistol, revolver, or ammunition, pursuant to Federal Law 18 U.S.C. 922(g)(8)9.
