

Who can claim this credit?

- **You may claim** – this credit for 2018 property taxes, payable in 2019, if on January 1, 2018, you were the owner of the property and used the property as your primary residence. You can have only one primary residence.
- **You cannot claim** – this credit on business property, rental units, land, garages or other properties that are not your primary residence. A non-Wisconsin resident cannot claim this credit.
