A quality address is defined by USPS® as:

“A quality address contains complete and correct elements that comply with USPS Address Management System standards and allows automated sortation to the intended delivery point for delivery to the specified recipient without requiring the use of Delivery Force Knowledge™ to complete.”

UNDELIVERABLE AS ADDRESSED


- Undeliverable As Addressed (UAA) costs the USPS more than \$1.8 billion each year to process.
- More than 6 billion mail pieces are disposed (recycled) of every year because of poor address quality – that means that they never left the Post Office and went straight into the recycle dumpster.
- Main reason: incorrect and outdated addressed on business-to-consumer mail.



- 45 million people move each year
- The typical consumer moves up to 11 times in their lifetime
- Two million new delivery points are added annually
- 4.7 million people marry each year, resulting in millions of name changes
- 1.9 million people divorce each year, causing more changed names
- Approximately 400-560 million pieces of mail each year are misdelivered/never reach their intended audience
- A USPS study shows that misdeliveries most often occur when the recipient's name or street number are incorrect
- These statistics are not declining – they are actually getting worse!

ADDRESSING

Delivery Address - All Mail must bear a delivery address

Except for simplified addresses, delivery addresses must contain from bottom to top:

- City, State & Zip+4
- Delivery Address Line
- Recipient Line (name of person or business)
- Attention Line
- Non-address information
(accounting numbers, subscription codes, etc.)

- If the delivery address does not allow for bldg numbers, **Suite numbers, etc, these elements should be placed on the line above the street address (Wrap Up)**
- For domestic mail, the Post Office (city), state and zip code or zip+4 information should be the last line of the address
- City State & Zip or Zip+4 (if field lengths do not allow all elements to fit on one line, place the zip code on the line immediately below the city, state (Wrap Down) – **THIS IS NOT A RECOMMENDED PROCEDURE**

DELIVERY ADDRESS FORMAT

Directionals

- Street addresses can contain predirectional and/or post-directionals in their name. There are 8 official geographic directional abbreviations:

N S E W NE NW SE SW

Secondary Address Unit Designators

- Mail addressed to multiunit building should include address unit designator: APARTMENT (APT) , SUITE (STE) , ROOM (RM) , FLOOR (FL), numbers

DO NOT use the pound sign (#) – the Postal equipment cannot read symbols.

DELIVERY ADDRESS FORMAT

Standard Abbreviations

- Generally 28 spaces (positions) are available in a mailer's data line for use in addresses

Street Names

- USPS prefers complete street names and cities
they should always be spelled out in their entirety and never abbreviated.
If you HAVE to abbreviate, the abbreviations MUST be USPS approved.

EXAMPLE: 123 ST JOHNS BLVD
MT PLEASANT MI

SHOULD BE: 123 SAINT JOHNS BLVD
MOUNT PLEASANT MI

DELIVERY ADDRESS FORMAT

NUMERIC STREET NAMES

- Spell out numeric street names only when there are duplicate street names within a postal delivery area.

GENERAL DELIVERY

- Use the words **GENERAL DELIVERY**, uppercase preferred, spelled out (no abbreviation), as the Delivery Address Line of the mailpiece. Each record will carry the -9999 “plus 4” code.

DELIVERY ADDRESS FORMAT

Street Suffix Abbreviations

- Very important in verifying the Zip Code – always use Postal approved abbreviations.
- When the street name contains two consecutive words that can be suffixes, spell out both words and abbreviate only the actual suffix.

BOULEVARD – BLVD

AVENUE – AVE

COURT – CT

STREET – ST

ADDRESS LINE COMPONENTS

Post Office Box Addresses

- Always use the prefix “PO BOX” followed by a space and then the box number

Dual Delivery Addresses

- **USPS discourages the use of dual delivery addresses that include both the street address and PO Box. If used, do not place both addresses on the same line. Mail is delivered to the address appearing on the line immediately above the city state & Zip.**

ADDRESS LINE COMPONENTS

Foreign Addresses

- The very last line of mail addresses to a foreign country should contain the country name printed in capital letters (NO ABBREVIATIONS) When using a foreign postal code, place it on the line above the country of destination.

ADDRESS LINE COMPONENTS

Military Addresses

- Overseas military addresses must contain the *APO* or *FPO* designation along with a two-character “state” abbreviation of *AE*, *AP*, or *AA* and the Zip Code or Zip+4 Code.

APO AE 09001-5275

FPO AP 96606-2783

APO AA 34035-4198

- *AE* is used for armed forces in Europe, the Middle East, Africa and Canada; *AP* is for the Pacific; and *AA* is the Americas excluding Canada.

9-1-1 Address Conversion

Addresses have a life cycle – USPS policy is to delivery to original address for one year following conversion






ADDRESS READABILITY

Typography

- Typography is the typesetting of letters and characters to form words that can be printed and read.
- Two most important factors in typesetting are legibility (measures whether type face characters can be perceived and distinguished from one another) and readability. (measures how easily and quickly typeset words can be read.)
- Type styles that are pleasant to the human eye are not necessarily easily readable by the OCR.

TYPE STYLES

- Simple Sans Serif type styles with uniform stroke width are best for OCR processing.
- Avoid type styles that are bold, script, extended, condensed, italicized and highly stylized – these are not OCR readable.

Unacceptable Type Styles

BOLD
EXTENDED
CONDENSED

Script

- Type size between 8 & 18 points are suitable for automated processing – however, 10 or 12 point is preferred.

CHARACTER SPACING

AIT

- One of the most important parameters for OCR readability
- The OCR requires space between characters in order to successfully image and read individual characters
- Kerning – The overlapping, or nesting, of characters - Not compatible with OCR processing

Left Justification

- All lines of text in the address block should be left justified

Upper Case vs. lowercase

- USPS prefers that you print all delivery address information in capital letters to improve character recognition

Punctuation

- USPS prefers that all punctuation be omitted in delivery addresses

Print Quality

- The performance of the OCR depends upon the print quality of addresses. Printed characters should present the highest contrast possible relative to the background they are printed on.

OCRs work best when the address is printed or typed in black ink on white background

ADDRESS BLOCK SKEW

- The address block should not be slanted or skewed (tilted) by more than 5 degrees relative to the bottom edge of the mailpiece (this is especially important for the proper application of address labels)



IT'S IN THE MAIL...BUT SHOULD IT BE? IMPROVING ADDRESS QUALITY

WHEN HANDWRITING

- Use block style characters (always avoid cursive) –print
- Avoid using ink that is not blue or black – **do not use red**
- Write addresses in straight lines (machines cannot read $\pm 5\%$ skew)
- Do not use markers or crayons



Ideally, place non-address printing such as logos and marketing copy above the delivery address line and as far away from the address block as possible

Dark shade indicates “free space” for non-address printing

Light shade indicates preferred clear zone to enhance readability

PAPER STOCK

- For letter size, mail must be a light color (white or pastel) and the address print must be black (or very dark) to provide adequate contrast for automated processing.
- The address bearing surface, whether on an envelope, card, label or insert, must have the ability to reflect sufficient light.




PAPER TYPES

- Certain materials are incompatible with postal automation because they cannot be transported at high speeds through mail processing equipment or they do not allow quality printing of a barcode on the mailpiece for optimal scanning such as polywrap, shrink-wrap and other plastic-like coverings.
- Certain types of coated papers should also be avoided if the coating is so glossy that it prevents the water-based ink used to print a postal applied barcode from drying within one second
- Avoid using textured paper – this can cause broken characters or smudged spaces
- Avoid using fluorescent paper – it can confuse the postal facer-canceller machines





DARK FIBERS & PATTERNS

- Envelope paper, or self-mailers should have sufficient opacity (density) to prevent any printing on the inside of the mail piece from showing through in the OCR read area or barcode clear zone
- Paper containing dark fibers or background patterns is not recommended – these can cause interference during OCR & BCS processing – the dark patterns can be mistaken for part of the address or barcode information, causing miss-sorts and delays

CLOSURES

- Protruding closures can cause damage to postal equipment and your mailpieces during processing – if using clasps, strings, buttons or similar closure devices, a nonmachinable surcharge may be applied.

Automating Your Mailpieces Odd-Shaped Items – Letters & Flats

- Contains items such as pens, pencils, or loose keys or coins that cause the thickness of the mailpiece to be uneven




- Also not permitted on automation-rate letter-size or flat-size mail

Automating Your Mailpieces

Flexibility - Letters

- Is it too rigid?
 - Does not bend easily when subjected to a transport belt tension of 40 pounds around an 11-inch diameter turn




- Automation-rate letter-size mail must be flexible

READABILITY/MACHINABILITY SUGGESTIONS FOR LETTERS AND FLATS

- Print City, State and Zip code on same line
- Print attention line above company name
- No punctuation
- All capital lettering
- Left justify the address block information

READABILITY/MACHINABILITY SUGGESTIONS FOR LETTERS AND FLATS

- Use uniform font size and spacing
- Address characters should not touch
- Use 10-12 point OCR readable font
- Avoid script and narrow fonts
