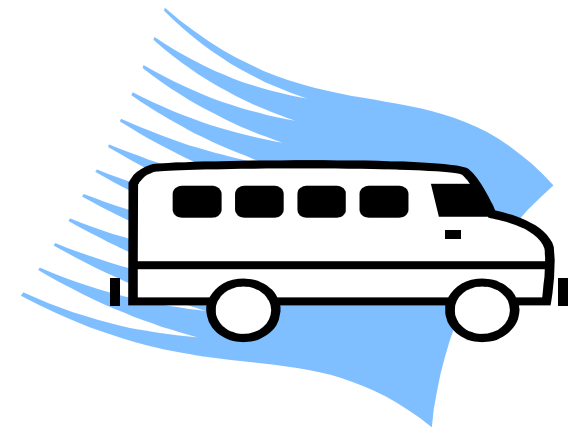

Getting on Board:

- Read down the list for the direction of the route and timing of the stops or call the driver to arrange a customize trip.
- Demand Response Customized trips are given between 8:00-9:00 am and 3:00-4:00 pm.
- Route A schedule runs in a clockwise direction and Route B runs in a counterclockwise direction
- The shuttle runs on a regular route, but may allow you to board and stop at other nearby locations. Simply ask the driver or call (262) 412-8641 and state where you'd like to go.
- Choose the pick-up time that's most convenient for you.
- All times are approximate, as the shuttle is subject to weather, traffic, and road construction. Your safety is of primary importance.

- Pay the driver as you board.
 - \$2.00 one way
 - \$3.00 roundtrip
 - \$5.00 all day unlimited use
 - Ask about a discounted PASS
- Driver has the right to refuse service

What is the Burlington SPARC Shuttle?

SPARC (Shuttling People Around Racine County) is an affordable and fun transportation service designed primarily for active Racine County seniors, making it convenient to get to appointments, needed services, volunteer opportunities, and special events in the community, or just to go shopping or visiting with family and friends. The choice is yours!

The general public is welcome to ride SPARC too, on a space available basis.

Where does SPARC go?

The schedule is printed inside this brochure. You can catch the shuttle at any of the scheduled timed stops, or you may also arrange to be picked up or dropped off at a location along the route by making a request to the driver. For more information you may call SPARC at **(262) 412-8641**.

When is SPARC in service?

The hours of operation are from **8:00am to 4:00pm** every Monday through Saturday.

Note: SPARC is not in service on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day

What does SPARC cost?

The cost to ride SPARC is:

- **\$2.00** for a one way, point to point trip
- **\$3.00** for a round trip that allows you to go out and back home
- **\$5.00** for a day pass that allows unlimited use in one day

A discounted **PASS** is also available onboard the shuttle.

So, get on board and go!

Although SPARC is not equipped to accommodate mobility devices other than collapsible walkers, other affordable transportation options for seniors and adults with disabilities are available.

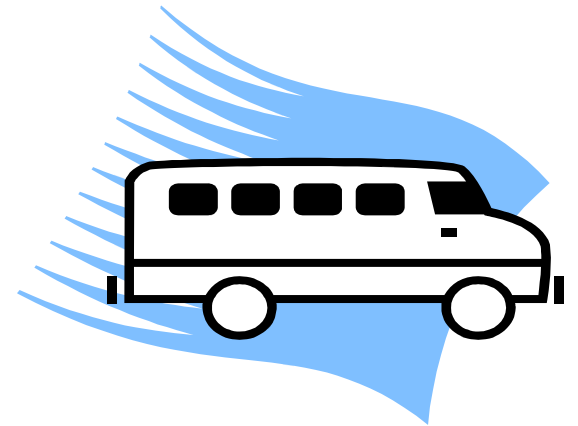
