3 **RESOLUTION BY THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & LAND USE PLANNING**
4 **COMMITTEE (ED&LUPC) RECOMMENDING THAT THE COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING**
5 **PUBLIC HEARING BE DELEGATED TO THE RACINE COUNTY ED&LUPC**

7 **To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:**

9 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes, all units of
10 government which engage in zoning, subdivision, or official mapping must adopt a
11 comprehensive plan by the year 2010; and

12
13 **WHEREAS**, the Racine County Board of Supervisors resolved to participate in the
14 preparation of a multi-jurisdictional comprehensive plan with all the cities, villages, and
15 towns in Racine County and authorized the Racine County Planning and Development
16 Department, under the direction of the ED&LUPC and with the Southeastern Wisconsin
17 Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC) as consultant, to take the lead in coordinating
18 the multi-jurisdictional planning effort to fully engage partner municipalities throughout the
19 process; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Racine County and partnering municipalities have conducted meetings
22 and other public participation activities during the course of development of the
23 comprehensive plan; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the Racine County Board of Supervisors created a Multi-Jurisdictional
26 Advisory Committee to guide the preparation of the comprehensive plan and that
27 Committee has completed its work; and

29 **WHEREAS**, the procedures for adopting comprehensive plans set forth in Section
30 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes, requires the political subdivision to hold at least
31 one public hearing at which the proposed ordinance or resolution is discussed; and

33 **WHEREAS**, the political subdivision referred to in Section 66.1001(4)(d) of the
34 Wisconsin Statutes is the Racine County Board of Supervisors; and

36 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 59.69(2)(e) of the Wisconsin Statutes, for matters
37 involving zoning requiring a public hearing, the Racine County ED&LUPC conducts the
38 related public hearings; and

40 **WHEREAS**, the ED&LUPC has experience in conducting public hearings and that it
41 is willing and able to conduct the public hearing on behalf of the County Board, the Board
42 may wish to delegate this task to the ED&LUPC.

44 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of
45 Supervisors to delegate the responsibility of conducting a public hearing for the Racine
46 County multi-jurisdictional comprehensive plan consistent with all the requirements
47 contained in Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes, regarding said public hearing to
48 the Racine County ED&LUPC.

4 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Planning & Development Department is
5 authorized to execute any documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
