BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County Public Works Department is hereby authorized and approved to enter into all necessary contracts to perform the replacement of the Ives Grove north truck storage facility wall.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors authorizes and approves the acceptance of an estimated insurance reimbursement from Local Government Property Insurance Fund in the amount of \$150,214.46.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfer of funds from the Racine County Public Liability Account to the Public Works Shop improvements account, as set forth in Exhibit "A" totaling \$25,000.00 to cover the Racine County insurance deductible is authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that additional terms and conditions may be applicable, as the Corporation Counsel and the Director of Public Works deem necessary and appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the County Board Chairman, the County Clerk, and/or the County Executive are authorized to sign any necessary documents or contracts to carry out the intent of this resolution.
