RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE EXISTING LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF ROCHESTER FOR FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE BASEBALL DIAMONDS AT CASE EAGLE PARK IN THE TOWN OF ROCHESTER.

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

 BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that an amendment to the existing license agreement with the Town of Rochester for the installation, operation and maintenance of future improvements to the existing two (2) baseball diamonds at Case Eagle Park including, but not limited to, sports lighting systems, scoreboards and water service is authorized and approved pursuant to the following terms and conditions:

1. That the plans for the sports lighting systems, scoreboards and water service shall be forwarded to the Department of Public Works for their review and written approval prior to work commencing at the site by contractors.

2. That all costs for improvements to the existing two (2) baseball diamonds undertaken as part of this agreement shall be incurred solely by the Town of Rochester.

3. That the installation of the improvements will be done by licensed contractors and none of the costs associated with installation will be incurred by Racine County.

4. That all work shall be installed in accordance with applicable National, State and Local codes, laws, ordinances and regulations. Comply with all applicable OSHA regulations.

5. That all permits and licenses required shall be secured and paid for by the Town of Rochester prior to work commencing at the site by contractors.

6. That the Town of Rochester is responsible for the operations, repair and/or maintenance of the improvements throughout the term of the license agreement.

7. That the Town of Rochester is responsible for the cost of electricity to operate the improvements that require a power source. Electric usage will be measured by an existing demand meter located in the electrical service distribution panel enclosure.

8. That the Town of Rochester is responsible for the cost of water usage at the baseball diamonds.

9. That the Town of Rochester shall be permitted to display advertisement signs on the scoreboards. All proposed advertisement signs shall be submitted to the Racine County Public Works, Parks and Facilities Committee for their review and written approval prior to sign installations. Signs shall be in compliance with the Racine County Code of Ordinances.
