1 April 15, 2008 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 2008-9** 3 RESOLUTION BY THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE 4 REQUESTING THAT THE STATE OF WISCONSIN INCREASE REIMBURSEMENT PAYMENTS FOR STATE PROBATION AND PAROLE 5 6 HOLDS HELD IN THE RACINE COUNTY JAIL 7 WHEREAS, Section 302.33 (2)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes requires the 8 Wisconsin Department of Corrections (DOC) to reimburse each county for the 9 maintenance of persons who are placed in the county jail or other county facility, 10 pending disposition of parole, extended supervision or probation revocation 11 proceedings; and 12 WHEREAS, Section 302.33 (2)(a)3 of the Wisconsin Statutes requires the 13 DOC to reimburse counties at the rate of \$40 per person per day, unless the total 14 amount appropriated for such reimbursements for any fiscal year is insufficient to 15 provide complete reimbursement at that rate, in which case DOC shall prorate 16 the payments to counties for that fiscal year; and 17 WHEREAS, the statutory rate of \$40 per person per day has not 18 increased since January 1, 1993, although that amount, adjusted for inflation as 19 measured by the Consumer Price Index, now exceeds \$56; and 20 WHEREAS, the Racine County Jail is mandated to accept placement of 21 DOC probation and parole holds; and 22 **WHEREAS**, the State of Wisconsin has continually and knowingly 23 underfunded DOC reimbursements for probation and parole holds, thereby 24 forcing the property taxpayers of Racine County and other Wisconsin counties to 25 subsidize this underfunded state mandate; and 26 WHEREAS, for State Fiscal Year 2007, the State of Wisconsin's 27 reimbursement to Racine County for probation and parole holds was only \$32 28 per person per day, resulting in a total shortfall to Racine County of \$51,688 for 29 that year, when measured against the \$40 amount prescribed in the statute. 30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Racine County Board of 31 Supervisors calls upon the Governor and the State Legislature to enact legislation that relieves Racine County property taxpayers of the burden of this 32 33 cost, which is clearly a state responsibility, by establishing a daily rate that 34 reflects actual costs and by appropriating sums sufficient to pay such daily rate 35 for all persons held on probation and parole holds in all affected facilities in the 36 State of Wisconsin. 37 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors 38 that the County Clerk forward copies of this resolution to Governor James Doyle, 39 Racine County's state legislators, and the Wisconsin Counties Association.
