The proposed home	occupation will be restricted to the following use (list below):

A home occupation is defined as any gainful occupation or profession engaged in by an occupant of a dwelling unit which meets the criteria listed below. The owner/applicant shall abide by the following criteria and shall attach supplementary information needed to complete this application.

Criteria is as follows:

- 1. The occupation shall be clearly incidental to the use of the dwelling unit as a residence, with one-half (1/2) or less of any floor being used for the home occupation. The applicant shall attach a copy of the residential floor plan outlining the precise area where the proposed home occupation shall be restricted.
- 2. No outdoor display or storage of materials, goods, supplies, or equipment used in the home occupation shall be permitted on the premises.
- 3. There shall be no visible evidence that a home occupation is being operated in the residence, except for **one** (1) permitted sign, which is a non-illuminated nameplate (name, address and type of home occupation) not to exceed two (2) square feet in area either mounted flat on the dwelling or a yard light post or sign post set back a minimum of five (5) feet from the highway right-of-way line. The applicant shall attach a copy of a plot plan identifying the location of the proposed sign, if applicable.
- 4. A maximum of two (2) persons other than members of the immediate family residing in the dwelling may be employed in the dwelling unit at any given time. The applicant for a home occupation permit must reside at the location of the proposed home occupation.
- 5. Except for storage of materials as allowed in Section 20-1008(f), no activity related to a home occupation shall be conducted in any detached structure or in any attached garage. Such storage of home occupation materials may not exceed two hundred (200) square feet of storage area (except in the Village of Caledonia). On-site tune-up, servicing, repair, salvage, wrecking, or painting services for non-property owner automobiles, trucks, boats, trailers, snowmobiles, recreational vehicles, or other motorized vehicles shall be prohibited as a home occupation.

- 6. No stock in-trade shall be displayed or sold upon the premises.
- 7. The home occupation shall not generate noise, vibration, glare, odors, fumes, or hazards detectable to the normal senses off the property.
- 8. No toxic, explosive, flammable, combustible, corrosive, radioactive or other restricted materials shall be used or stored on the site for home occupation purposes. There shall be no loading of bullets; preparation of ammunition; or sale, trade, lease or rental of firearms and/or ammunition in a home occupation. This does not preclude a home occupation for a gunsmith for the service or repair of firearms or for a firearm collector, licensed by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms.
- 9. The use shall not require more than two (2) additional off-street parking spaces for clients or customers. **The applicant shall attach a plot plan** outlining the parking area.
- 10. No equipment or process shall be used which creates visual or audible electrical interference in any radio or television receiver off the premises or causes fluctuations in line voltage off the premises.
