A person who knowingly obtains, discloses or uses personal information, from a motor vehicle record, for a purpose not permitted, shall be liable to the individual to whom the information pertains. The court may award: (1) actual damages, but not less than liquidated damages in the amount of \$2,500; (2) punitive damages upon proof of willful or reckless disregard of the law; (3) reasonable attorneys' fees and other litigation costs reasonably incurred; and (4) such other preliminary and equitable relief as the court determines to be appropriate. 18 U.S.C. § 2724(a).
