You can have only one primary residence. You cannot claim this credit on business property, rental units, land, garages or other properties that are not your primary residence. A non-Wisconsin resident cannot claim this credit.

If the property qualified as your primary residence on January 1, 2016, submit this completed form to your County Treasurer. The credit will appear on your 2016 property tax bill.
