

You may claim the lottery and gaming credit for 2015 property taxes, payable in 2016, if on January 1, 2015, you owned the property and used the property as your primary residence. You can have only one primary residence. You cannot claim this credit on business property, rental units, land, garages or other properties that are not your primary residence. A non-Wisconsin resident cannot claim this credit.

If the property qualified as your primary residence on **January 1, 2015, and you did not receive the credit on your 2015 property tax bills**, submit to the **Wisconsin Department of Revenue (DOR)**:

- This completed application
- Copy of your 2015 property tax bill

Note: If the property qualified as your primary residence on **January 1, 2016**, submit Form LC-100 to your **County Treasurer** to claim the 2016 credit.
