 **WHEREAS**, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, which was duly created by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin in accordance with Section 66.0309(2) of the *Wisconsin Statutes* on the 8th day of August 1960, upon petition of the Counties of Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha, has the function and duty of making and adopting a master plan for the physical development of the Southeastern Wisconsin Region; and

**WHEREAS**, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission adopted on June 21, 2006, a land use plan for the development of the Region to the year 2035; and

 **WHEREAS**, the year 2035 regional land use plan and the supporting inventories, analyses, objectives, principles, standards, and forecasts are set forth in a published report entitled SEWRPC Planning Report No. 48, *A Regional Land Use Plan for Southeastern Wisconsin: 2035*; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has transmitted certified copies of its resolution adopting that land use plan, together with the aforementioned SEWRPC Planning Report No. 48, to the local units of government of the Southeastern Wisconsin Region; and

WHEREAS, the County of Racine believes that the land use plan prepared by the Commission will be a valuable guide not only to the development of the Region but of Racine County as well, and that the endorsement of such plan by the Racine County Board of Supervisors will assure a common understanding by the several governmental levels and agencies concerned and enable their staffs to program the necessary area wide and local plan implementation work.
