7 **WHEREAS**, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, which
8 was duly created by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin in accordance with Section
9 66.0309(2) of the *Wisconsin Statutes* on the 8th day of August 1960, upon petition of the
10 Counties of Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington, and
11 Waukesha, has the function and duty of making and adopting a master plan for the
12 physical development of the Southeastern Wisconsin Region; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission adopted
15 on June 21, 2006, a land use plan for the development of the Region to the year 2035; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the year 2035 regional land use plan and the supporting inventories,
18 analyses, objectives, principles, standards, and forecasts are set forth in a published report
19 entitled SEWRPC Planning Report No. 48, *A Regional Land Use Plan for Southeastern*
20 *Wisconsin: 2035*; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Commission has transmitted certified copies of its resolution
23 adopting that land use plan, together with the aforementioned SEWRPC Planning Report
24 No. 48, to the local units of government of the Southeastern Wisconsin Region; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the County of Racine believes that the land use plan prepared by the
27 Commission will be a valuable guide not only to the development of the Region but of
28 Racine County as well, and that the endorsement of such plan by the Racine County
29 Board of Supervisors will assure a common understanding by the several governmental
30 levels and agencies concerned and enable their staffs to program the necessary area wide
31 and local plan implementation work.
