**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Purchasing Department is authorized to waive any bidding requirements and to purchase one state specified HCSB 1400-SS automatic salt brine production unit for the Department of Public Works to be used for winter highway maintenance traffic control operations at a price not to exceed \$25,000.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to make water and electrical connections and in any way install such equipment at the county highway maintenance facilities at Ives Grove

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the County Board Chairman, the County Clerk and/or the County Executive are authorized to sign any necessary contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
