COUNSELING SERVICES FOR THE DRUG COURT**

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that pursuant to Sec. 7-230 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances, any and all bidding requirements are hereby waived and a contract with Racine Psychological Services and Zimmerman Consulting for the period of October 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007 to provide counseling services for the Drug Court is authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that it is determined to be in the best interest of Racine County to utilize the services of Racine Psychological Services and Zimmerman Consulting as they are part of the core team involved in the Drug Court program since its inception.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Executive, the County Clerk and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
