7 **WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's Department 2006 Budget proposal called for funding to
8 purchase ten (10) new Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor squad cars; and
9

10 **WHEREAS**, only six (6) squads were approved in the budget resolution; and
11

12 **WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's Department is beginning to experience major failures in
13 some of their high-mileage squad cars and our fleet is in critical need of these additional
14 four (4) marked squad cars for use in daily patrol activities; and
15

16 **WHEREAS**, the requested transfer amount is the net cost required after an
17 estimated earned revenue of \$12,000.00 from the auction sale of the four vehicles that will
18 be replaced; and
19

20 **WHEREAS**, the cars would be purchased from the same approved vendor that the
21 original six cars were purchased from – Ewald Hartford Ford; and

23 **WHEREAS**, it is necessary to accept said funds and to transfer funds into
24 appropriate Sheriff's Department accounts.
