1 May 9, 2006 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 2006-13** 3 RESOLUTION BY THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE 4 REQUESTING THAT THE STATE'S LEGISLATIVE AUDIT BUREAU BE 5 DIRECTED TO AUDIT DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE CALCULATIONS AND 6 PAYMENTS OF SALES TAX RECEIPTS IN COUNTIES SUBJECT TO THE 7 SOUTHEAST WISCONSIN PROFESSIONAL BASEBALL PARK DISTRICT **SALES TAX** 8 9 WHEREAS, Racine County is one of the five counties that compose the 10 Southeast Wisconsin Professional Baseball Park District; and 11 WHEREAS, for that reason, Racine County is subject to a 0.1% sales tax 12 that is collected exclusively for the purpose of retiring the debt of the Southeast 13 Wisconsin Professional Baseball Park District; and 14 WHEREAS, the obligations of Racine County businesses to collect, and of 15 Racine County residents to pay, said special district sales tax continue until the total of all such revenues collected within the five-county district are sufficient to 16 17 retire the debt; and 18 WHEREAS, the district and each county within it must rely entirely on the 19 Wisconsin Department of Revenue's calculations and payments of the proceeds 20 of the special district sales tax; and 21 WHEREAS, numerous reports indicate a history of substantial 22 inaccuracies in the Department of Revenue's calculations and payments of sales 23 tax proceeds due to individual counties and special districts; and 24 WHEREAS, the inaccuracies are especially notable for sales tax 25 calculations and payments for the district and the counties that compose it; and 26 WHEREAS, failure of the Department of Revenue to ensure full credit to 27 the Southeast Wisconsin Professional Baseball Park District of all proceeds of 28 the special district sales tax will require Racine County businesses to collect, and 29 of Racine County residents to pay, said special district sales tax longer than 30 necessary. 31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Racine County Board of 32 Supervisors calls upon the State Legislature, and in particular the Joint 33 Committee on Audit, to direct the Legislative Audit Bureau to conduct an audit of the Department of Revenue's program for collection, calculation, and payment of 34 local sales tax proceeds, with special attention to the proceeds of the sales tax 35 36 for the Southeast Wisconsin Professional Baseball Park District. 37
