WHEREAS, Section 2-441 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances directed the Information Systems Director to conduct a privacy impact assessment and obtain County Board approval before developing information technology that disseminates personal identifying information to the public on the internet; and

WHEREAS, the Racine County Human Resources Department desires to have a more efficient means for applicants to apply for Racine County positions and a method for Racine County to track candidate information and to obtain relevant applicant reports, by developing an on-line capability; and

WHEREAS, such applications require collection of personal identifying information, primarily for use by Racine County staff, but also perhaps for dissemination outside of Racine County staff for legitimate purposes associated with the hiring process; and
