8 **WHEREAS**, Section 2-441 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances directed the
9 Information Systems Director to conduct a privacy impact assessment and obtain County
10 Board approval before developing information technology that disseminates personal
11 identifying information to the public on the internet; and
12

13 **WHEREAS**, the Racine County Human Resources Department desires to have a
14 more efficient means for applicants to apply for Racine County positions and a method for
15 Racine County to track candidate information and to obtain relevant applicant reports, by
16 developing an on-line capability; and
17

18 **WHEREAS**, such applications require collection of personal identifying information,
19 primarily for use by Racine County staff, but also perhaps for dissemination outside of Racine
20 County staff for legitimate purposes associated with the hiring process; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Information Systems Director has previously developed and produced
23 the impact assessment and now has concluded the Racine County Privacy Report
24 Questionnaire as attached in Exhibit "A".
