RESOLUTION BY THE HEALTH AND HUMAN DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$180,000.00 FROM THE LAND SALES ACCOUNT AND AUTHORIZING A GRANT TO FACILITATE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF A COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER IN RACINE COUNTY

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfer of \$180,000.00 from the Land Sales account as set forth in "Exhibit A" which is attached hereto is authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the grant of \$180,000.00 to the Beloit Area Community Health Center, Inc., to facilitate the establishment and operation of a Community Health Center in Racine County is authorized and approved upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. This shall be a one-time payment and shall not create any expectation of future funding by Racine County; and
- 2. Actual disbursement of funds to the Beloit Area Community Health Center, Inc., shall be conditioned on:
 - Public commitment of funds by the City of Racine and private sources in amounts that, together with this grant, will provide funding adequate for the initial establishment of a Community Health Center in Racine County; and
 - Mutually satisfactory understandings between Beloit Area Community Health Center, Inc. and existing Racine County entities that provide substantial health care to the county's uninsured and underinsured populations, such as Health Care Network and Racine Family Practice Residency Program, to maximize collaboration and minimize competition; and
 - c. Such other terms and conditions as the Corporation Counsel and the Finance Director deem necessary and appropriate.

 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Executive, the County Clerk and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
