WHEREAS, Section 2-441 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances directs the Information Systems Director to conduct a privacy impact assessment and obtain County Board approval before developing information technology that disseminates personal identifying information to the public on the internet; and

WHEREAS, the Racine County Human Services Department desires to have a more efficient website for citizens to use and better understand Racine County government services; and

WHEREAS, such use occasionally requires collection of personal identifying information, primarily for use by Racine County staff, but also perhaps for dissemination outside of Racine County staff; and

WHEREAS, the Information Systems Director has previously developed and produced the impact assessment and now has concluded the Racine County Privacy Report Questionnaire as attached in Exhibit "A".
