8 **WHEREAS**, Section 2-441 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances directs the  
9 Information Systems Director to conduct a privacy impact assessment and obtain County  
10 Board approval before developing information technology that disseminates personal  
11 identifying information to the public on the internet; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Racine County Human Services Department desires to have a more  
14 efficient website for citizens to use and better understand Racine County government  
15 services; and

17 **WHEREAS**, such use occasionally requires collection of personal identifying  
18 information, primarily for use by Racine County staff, but also perhaps for dissemination  
19 outside of Racine County staff; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Information Systems Director has previously developed and produced  
22 the impact assessment and now has concluded the Racine County Privacy Report  
23 Questionnaire as attached in Exhibit "A".
