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7 **WHEREAS**, The Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services is
8 expanding Family Care to Racine County in 2007; and

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10 **WHEREAS**, An Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) is designed to be
11 the point of entry of services and information for all adults with long term care needs or
12 disabilities. The ADRC will provide information, assistance, referral, eligibility
13 determination, and options counseling services; and

15 **WHEREAS**, As a comprehensive Human Services Department, that includes as a
16 part of its departmental structure, the Aging Unit, the Long Term Support Unit, the Mental
17 Health Unit, and the Economic Support Division, the RCHSD intends to apply to DHFS to
18 implement and operate the ADRC for Racine County; and

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20 **WHEREAS**, In addition to the necessary units with the Human Services
21 Department, coordination and collaboration with the Racine County Long Term Support
22 Committee and the Commission on Aging will occur; and

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24 **WHEREAS**, The proposed implementation of the Racine County ADRC is
25 scheduled for November 1 2006. If Racine County is awarded the contract to implement
26 and operate the ADRC, HSD will implement the ADRC within the established guidelines
27 and funding from the State of Wisconsin, and serve all adults who are elderly,
28 developmentally disabled, physically disabled, mentally ill, or have substance abuse
29 issues.
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
