BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the acceptance of a Jail Literacy grant in the amount of \$30,000.00 with a local match of \$3,333.00 from the Office of Justice Assistance is authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfer of funds as set forth in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein is authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that various contracts with Gateway Technical College, Good Samaritan Life Center and Zimmerman Consulting Incorporated for the implementation of the program are authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Clerk, the County Executive and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
