BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfer of funds as set forth in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein is authorized and approved within the Sheriff's Department's 2005 budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Clerk, the County Executive and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution subject to review and approval by the Corporation Counsel, the Racine County Sheriff and the Finance Director.
