WHEREAS, in order to reduce the recidivism rate of Racine County Jail inmates, effective programming space is needed to give those inmates tools to become productive members of society; and

WHEREAS, the current sally port, used simultaneously by law enforcement for transition of inmates and used by vendors to deliver supplies to the Jail, as well as the inmates booking area are of insufficient space and need security improvement; and

WHEREAS, a series of investigations, studies and reports since 1999 from Racine County staff, citizens and consultants have reviewed conditions of the current jail and made recommendations for improvements.
