To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that various improvements at the Robert L. Rohner Training Center are authorized and approved pursuant to the following terms and conditions:

1. That the improvements are those previously authorized by Resolution No. 2004-99 which accepted funds for said improvements and Resolution No. 2004-193 which authorized preliminary design and architectural and engineering work for said improvements.

2. That the improvements shall consist generally of:

- a. A new training center building, furniture and equipment.
- b. Additional firing positions.
- c. A two-story range tower.
- d. A pneumatic turning target system.
- e. Covered outdoor bleacher-type seating area.
- f. Covered outdoor weapons cleaning area.
- g. A shoot house.

3. That the total cost for said project shall not exceed \$1,436,737.61.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfer of funds as set forth in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein is authorized and approved.

 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Clerk, the County Executive and/or the County Executive are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
