RESOLUTION BY THE FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING AMENDMENTS TO THE 2006 RACINE COUNTY EXECUTIVE BUDGET AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET AS AMENDED

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the 2006 Racine County Budget be amended as set forth in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that as amended the 2006 Racine County Budget which is incorporated herein by reference be and is hereby adopted. A copy of the 2006 Racine County Executive Budget shall be on file with the Racine County Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the capital projects as set forth in "CAPITAL PROJECTS" p. 44-2 and pages 45-24 through 45-31 of the Racine County 2006 Budget are hereby authorized and approved provided that, any projects that are to be funded through the proceeds of a bond sale are contingent on the County Board authorizing the appropriate bond sale through the passage of appropriate authorizing resolution. The capital projects that are approved in this budget are nonlapsing capital projects and shall continue from year to year until completed or until deauthorized by the Racine County Board of Supervisors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the added positions, eliminated positions and reclassifications as shown in pages 45-3 through 45-5 of the Racine County 2006 Budget are authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the fees set forth on pages 45-11 through 45-23 of the Racine County 2006 Budget are authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County budget is adopted by the Racine County Board of Supervisors at the level stated on the Authorized Budget page.

Capital Projects – The level of control on the Authorized Budget Page are at the cost center level.

Transfers between any of the specified budget level of control may be made by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to Sec. 2-86 Racine County Code of Ordinances or by the Finance and Human Resources Committee pursuant to Sec. 2-130 Racine County Code of Ordinances.

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The Racine County Budget also contains the Budget Detail Supplemental page, which is the detail supporting the Authorized Budget Page and is intended only to be supplemental information and not adopted by the Racine County Board of Supervisors. The Finance Director is authorized to establish the accounts as set forth in the Budget Detail Supplemental page. Transfers are allowed between the accounts established by the Finance Director and the County Executive. A report on all such transfers shall be submitted to the Racine County Finance and Human Resources Committee by the Finance Department on a guarterly basis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the County Executive is authorized to increase the non-represented employees general salary by up to 2% effective July 1, 2006 and to adjust the non-represented salary ranges by the same percentage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County shall not calculate the health insurance premium charged to active employees and retirees based on actuarial calculations which combine the two groups, but shall continue to calculate separate premium rates for the active employee group and the retiree group.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Finance Director is authorized to make any technical corrections in the budget are deemed necessary.
