**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Board Chairman, the County Clerk and/or the County Executive are authorized to execute a state aid contract with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation under Section 85.21 of the Wisconsin Statutes on behalf of Racine County.

8 **WHEREAS**, Section 85.21 of the Wisconsin Statutes authorizes the Wisconsin  
9 Department of Transportation to make grants to the counties of Wisconsin for the  
10 purpose of assisting them in providing specialized transportation to the elderly and the
