5 **WHEREAS**, Racine County is currently in the process of upgrading various
6 software systems including the removal of the AS400 system and replacing it with
7 Windows SQL Server; and

8
9 **WHEREAS**, the Register of Deeds Office uses software systems Trimin,
10 Transcendent, IMS 21 Imaging and ESRI GIS (Prowest), which were custom developed to
11 work with AS400 but are not currently compatible with the new Windows SQL Server; and

12
13 **WHEREAS**, new modules and services must be developed with the vendors to
14 make these systems compatible with the new Windows SQL Server; and

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16 **WHEREAS**, in early September 2016, some Trimin connections broke during the
17 transition from AS400; and

18
19 **WHEREAS**, the deadline for the upgrades and transitions is January 1, 2017, and

20
21 **WHEREAS**, in order to meet the transition deadline, the Register of Deeds requests
22 the capital projects approval from the Register of Deeds Capital Purchase account where
23 there are sufficient funds to cover the costs.
