In Wisconsin:

37% of drunk driving convictions are repeat offenders.

There were 23,931 convictions for drunk driving offenses last year.

Alcohol related crashes killed 190 people & injured nearly **2,872** in 2015

> 33.7% of all fatal traffic crashes in 2015 were alcohol-related.

41.3% of all fatal motorcycle crashes were alcohol-related.

A Decision You'll Regret the Rest of Your Life

If you're arrested, you can lose your license & be fined.

Repeat drunken drivers face imprisonment.

If you hurt or kill someone in a crash, you could face serious charges like negligent homicide or operating while intoxicated (OWI) causing injury.





Entirely Preventable

Choose a sober designated driver.

If you're feeling buzzed, you're likely over the **0.08 limit** and should not drive. Rather than risk arrest or a crash, take mass transit, a taxicab or ask a sober friend to drive you home.
