# Asphalt Milling Services

### GENERAL INFORMATION

The purpose of these specifications is to relate Racine County's requirements for purchasing the services described.

Any item omitted which is clearly necessary for the satisfactory performance of the proposed service, even though not directly specified, shall be considered a part of the contract.

### WORK REQUIRED

The ability to supply either a 4' (ft.), 6' (ft.), 7'(ft.) or 8' (ft.) milling services to grind off old, existing asphalt at various locations within Racine County as directed by the project coordinator.

The ability to supply the proper size mill requested within a (2) two-week period from the day we call the contractor.

The traffic control will be provided by Racine County.

Racine County is looking for **ONLY** the milling services and operator. All other equipment would be supplied by Racine County (i.e.; broom, skid loader etc....).

### CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Contractor shall indemnify, keep and save harmless the County of Racine, their agents, officials and employees, against all injuries, deaths, loss, damages, claims, suits, liabilities, judgments, costs and expenses, which may arise directly or indirectly from any negligence or from the reckless or willful misconduct of the Contractor or his employees, or of any Subcontractors, or any of their Material Suppliers, or employees. The Contractor shall at his own expense, appear, defend and pay all charges of attorneys and any other expenses arising therefrom or incurred in connection therewith. If any judgment shall be rendered against the County of Racine in any such action, the Contractor shall, at his own expense, satisfy and discharge the same.

The Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless Racine County against any liens filed for nonpayment of his bills about the project.

### STANDARDS

All work shall be done in a thorough, professional manner by skilled labor experienced in performing asphalt milling.

### INSPECTION

All completed work by the Contractor shall be subject always to the observation and approval of Racine County representatives.
