On March 24th, at approximately 6:25am, agents from the Racine County Metro Drug Unit, the Racine County Sheriff's Office S.W.A.T and a RASO K-9 officer executed a search warrant in the 1800 block of Clayton Ave in the city of Racine.

Information had been developed that the suspect at this residence, was involved in the sale of cocaine. The suspect, Jarvis Booker, was recently released from prison for delivery of cocaine charges and is currently on probation for the same. Located during the search of the residence was 117.9 grams of crack cocaine, various pills, ecstasy, marijuana, drug paraphernalia, a loaded handgun, ammunition, quest card, cell phones, and US currency. There were three young children found to be living in the residence as well, therefore the Racine County Human Services Department(HSD) was contacted and responded to the residence under the drug endangered children protocol.

Booker was transported to the Racine County Jail for the following charges:

- Possession of cocaine with intent to deliver
- Repeat drug offender
- Keeper of a drug place
- Possession of a firearm by felon
- Possession of drug paraphernalia
- 2ND degree reckless endangering safety (ref kids in the residence)
- On State Probation
