## **COUNTY EXECUTIVE'S NEXT TWO LISTENING SESSIONS:**

May 24th: Village of Union Grove, June 1st: Village of Mount Pleasant

Racine – Racine County Executive Jonathan Delagrave announced today his next two monthly listening sessions will be held on consecutive weeks: Wednesday, May 24, 2017 at the Village of Union Grove, 925 – 15th Avenue, Union Grove, and **Thursday**, June 1, 2017 at the Village of Mount Pleasant, 8811 Campus Drive, Mount Pleasant. He will be available to meet county residents from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm.

Accompanying Delagrave in Union Grove will be members of the County Executive's staff and members of the Human Services Department who will be on hand to explain the County services available in the Western Racine County Service Center in Burlington. The Western Racine County Service Center offers many of the same services that are offered in Racine, such as instructor led Workshops, current job postings, a computer lab for customers to apply for jobs or build their resumes, and online Gale Courses. Workforce Solutions provides many no-fee services for Racine County residents who are looking for employment or wanting to enhance their skills. The center also can help residents with the application process and ongoing case management of State and Federal programs such as Foodshare, Healthcare, and Childcare.

"My intent is to maintain a strong County presence and efficient delivery of services in western Racine County," stated Delagrave. Residents interested in the future of the Western Racine County Service Center which is slated to be demolished in late 2017 or early 2018, are also encouraged to attend this listening session.

"The purpose of my listening sessions is to engage Racine County residents and share County news and information. It's important that residents know what County services are available to help them in their everyday lives," added Delagrave.

Delagrave's listening sessions are usually scheduled on the second Wednesday of the month, from 4:00 pm - 6:00 pm, although these days are subject to change. The next listening session is scheduled for Wednesday, July 12, 2017: Town of Norway, Col. Heg Hall, 6419 Heg Park Road, Wind Lake. Other elected officials and County Supervisors also attend these listening sessions, if their schedules permit.
