**RACINE COUNTY HIGHWAY "A" TO CLOSE BETWEEN  
USH 45 and CTH "C" FOR BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION**

*Closure to Begin Monday, August 14, 2017*

Yorkville – A large culvert over the West Branch Root River Canal will be removed and replaced with a bridge this year. Racine County Highway "A" (Plank Road) will be closed to all traffic starting Monday, August 14, 2017 between USH 45 (N Colony Avenue) and CTH "C" (Spring Street). The bridge closure is expected to last about 2 1/2 months. The bridge is expected to open in late October 2017, but the construction schedule is weather dependent.

County Highway "A" will be closed to all traffic at the bridge construction site 1/2 mile east of 61<sup>st</sup> Drive. A detour will be posted for County Highway "A" traffic to use USH 45 north of CTH A, and STH 20 between USH 45 and CTH C. Motorists should schedule an extra 5 minutes to drive the detour route.
