RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE TO REQUEST THAT THE CITY OF RACINE ELIMINATE AND RECREATE THE TWO-TIERED PAY SYSTEM FOR RACINE COUNTY VS. NON-RACINE COUNTY RESIDENTS AT THE FIFTH STREET BOAT LAUNCH, WHICH IS THE ONLY PUBLIC BOAT LAUNCH IN RACINE COUNTY FOR ACCESS TO LAKE MICHIGAN

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County has received concerns from various Racine County residents and others who would like to see a single pay rate for boat launching replace a tiered system for Racine County resident vs. non-Racine County resident users of the Fifth Street boat launch owned by the City of Racine.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Racine County Board of Supervisors hereby request that the City of Racine eliminate the two-tiered launch fee currently being used and implement as of January 1, 2018, a fee that allows Racine County residents to pay one fee and to impose a different launch fee for non-Racine County residents.

16 17 18 19	<b>WHEREAS,</b> Racine County owns the small boat basin which is used to launch boats from the Fifth Street boat launch; and
20 21	WHEREAS, The City of Racine owns the Fifth Street Boat Launch, and
22 23 24	<b>WHEREAS,</b> The City of Racine charges different launch fees for city residents versus non-city residents; and
25 26	WHEREAS, the two-tiered pay system is allowed under the State codes and is legal; and
27 28 29	<b>WHEREAS</b> , The Fifth Street boat launch is the only public boat launch that allows access to Lake Michigan in Racine County; and
30 31 32 33 34	<b>WHEREAS</b> , there have been complaints received by County staff and the County Executive that a two-tiered launch fee for City vs non-City residents is unfair with the Fifth Street location being the only place to legally launch a boat from a public boat launch into Lake Michigan in Racine County; and
35 36 37	<b>WHEREAS,</b> Racine County staff, the Racine County Executive and the Racine County Public Works, Parks and Facilities Committee agree that there should be one fee for all Racine County residents and another fee for non-Racine County residents, effective January 1, 2018.
