RESOLUTION BY THE RACINE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDING ADOPTION OF VISION 2050: A REGIONAL LAND USE AND TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM PLAN FOR SOUTHEASTERN WISCONSIN

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

WHEREAS, VISION 2050 is a long-range land use and transportation plan developed by the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC) over a three-year period for the seven-county Southeastern Wisconsin Region comprised of Racine County, Kenosha County, Milwaukee County, Walworth County, Waukesha County, Washington County, and Ozaukee County.

WHEREAS, the VISION 2050 process was guided by the Commission's Advisory Committees on Regional Land Use Planning and Regional Transportation System Planning, with input also provided by the Commission's Environmental Justice Task Force, Jurisdictional Highway Planning Committees for each county and VISION 2050 Task Forces on key areas of interest.

WHEREAS, VISION 2050 seeks to build on the Region's existing strengths and improve areas where the Region does not compete well with its peers in order to improve the quality of life for residents and businesses and attract new growth to the Region.

WHEREAS, VISION 2050 key recommendations include the following:

- (1) preserving the Region's primary environmental corridors, which encompass the best remaining features of the Region's natural landscape, areas in the Region with the highest groundwater recharge potential, and the most productive farmland; and
- (2) encouraging more compact development, ranging from high-density transit-oriented development to traditional neighborhoods with homes within walking distance to parks ,schools, and businesses; and
- (3) significantly improving and expanding public transit, including adding rapid transit, to support compact growth and enhance the attractiveness and accessibility of the Region; and
- (4) enhancing the Region's bicycle and pedestrian network to improve access to activity centers, neighborhoods, and other destinations; and
- (5) keeping existing major streets in a state of good repair and efficiently using the capacity of existing streets and highways; and
- (6) strategically adding capacity on congested roadways and incorporating "complete streets" roadway design concepts to provide safe and convenient travel for all.

WHEREAS, the Regional Planning Commission adopted the plan on July 28, 2016.

WHEREAS, the Racine County Economic Development and Land Use Planning

Committee hereby endorses and recommends adoption of the VISION 2050: A Regional Land Use and Transportation System Plan for Southeastern Wisconsin.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Racine County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts *VISION 2050: A Regional Land Use and Transportation System Plan for Southeastern Wisconsin* as a guide and a shared long-range vision of future land use and transportation in Southeastern Wisconsin.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County Clerk is directed to transmit copies of this resolution to the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC), to the Racine County Clerk, the Kenosha County Clerk, the Milwaukee County Clerk, the Walworth County Clerk, the Waukesha County Clerk, the Washington County Clerk, the Ozaukee County Clerk and all municipal clerks in Racine County within seven (7) days after this resolution is adopted.
