BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Human Services Department is hereby authorized and approved to contract with a third party for operation of a youth Shelter Facility or Receiving Home within Racine County which can offer around-the-clock care and supervision for infants and children.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the execution of these contracts and any contract addenda shall be subject to the review and approval of the Corporation Counsel and the Human Services Director.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the County Clerk, the County Board Chairman and/or the County Executive are authorized to execute any contracts or contract addenda to carry out the intent of this resolution.

WHEREAS , there are currently 360 children in out-of-home care, a 40% increase over 2016; and

WHEREAS, placements are often made under emergency circumstances with little time to select the most appropriate home; there are a limited number of available foster homes in Racine County and sibling groups are often separated because of the lack of homes able to accommodate them; and

WHEREAS, infants and children with special needs often require specialized care available only through a limited number of homes; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the hardship faced by so many children who must be removed from their homes to provide a safe, nurturing setting until relatives or longer term foster home placement can be established, Human Services is proposing to contract with a third party for operation of a youth Shelter Facility or Receiving Home within Racine County which can offer around-the-clock care and supervision for infants and children, at any given time; and

WHEREAS, a shelter care facility may be used for the temporary care of children taken into protective custody, in need of transitional placements in emergency situations, or placed in the shelter care facility by order of the court; and

WHEREAS, the authority for a county board of supervisors to establish a shelter care facility and to delegate its authority to contract with privately operated shelter care facilities for purchase of services to its county department is set forth at Wis. Stat. § 938.22.
