WHEREAS, Racine County benefits from contracting with another county for autopsy and related services, rather than needing to arrange for its own autopsy facilities, and to perform such services with its own employees or by contract with an individual pathologist; and

WHEREAS, the new contract with the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office will maintain the previous contract fee for autopsies at \$1,600.00 each and will include pathologist dissection, routine toxicology, photography, digital radiography, histology, and the storage of bodies at the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days; and

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office will provide courtroom testimony concerning any autopsy at the rate of \$500.00 per hour; and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County has provided quality professional pathologist and related services during the term of the previous agreement; and

WHEREAS, Racine County deems the terms and conditions of the proposed agreement with Milwaukee County advantageous to Racine County; and

WHEREAS, funding for autopsies is included in the 2018 Racine County Medical Examiner's Budget in the "MS-Autopsies" account.
