To the Honorable members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County Public Works respectfully requests, to purchase a three-lane anti-icing sprayer unit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that funds are available and shall be used for the purchase from the Public Works Performance Based Maintenance (PBM) Account and transferred to Account Number MA344.488000, 2018 Machinery.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that this equipment to be purchased followed procurement protocols, having letterhead quotations for pricing, as set forth in Exhibit "B" that is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the three-lane anti-icing sprayer that best fits the requirements and pricing of the Public Works Division will cost \$9339.70, along with approximately \$2500.00 in shipping costs and additional items that may be required for it to operate properly in the single-axle dump truck.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the purchase of the three-lane anti-icing sprayer is authorized and the transfer of funds approved, not to exceed \$12,000.00, as set forth in Exhibit "A" that is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

- WHEREAS, Racine County requests the purchase of an anti-icing sprayer for use at the Rochester facility to pre-treat roads and bridge decks with a salt brine product; and
- WHEREAS, funds for this purchase are from over recovery of the State Performance Based Maintenance (PBM) Program work that the department has completed in past years for the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT); and
- **WHEREAS**, anti-icing sprayers are used for controlling snow and ice by preventing the formation on roadways prior to the storm; and
- **WHEREAS**, when pavement is pre-treated with salt brine prior to a storm, snow or ice will not bond to the pavement surface in most cases; and
- **WHEREAS**, the non-binding of snow and ice to the surface of the pavement helps Racine County become more efficient when the storm arrives by using less material (salt) and manpower to clear roads; and
- **WHEREAS**, currently the county has one anti-icing sprayer unit at the Ives Grove facility that must cover the entire county; and
- **WHEREAS**, currently some of the roadways prior to a storm event cannot be treated due to a timing factor and the amount of area needing to be covered with only one anti-icing sprayer unit available; and
- **WHEREAS**, having two units, one east (Ives) and one west (Rochester), will allow for better coverage in shorter amount of time and having the assurance all our treated areas on the program list will be applicated.

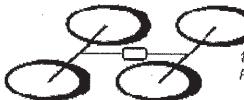
Freight Terms: All sales made by Seller to Buyer shall be F.O.B. Seller's Distribution Center.
