20 21 22 23	<b>WHEREAS</b> , as part of this review, it is recommended that three of the current second shift mobile response positions, which are currently contracted employees, be converted to County full-time positions; and
23 24 25 26	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the positions will be titled Mobile Response Crisis Worker I (N102) or II (N120 depending on experience level; and
27 28 29 30	WHEREAS, this action will allow for a reduction in the turnover of staff, which is currently above 75% annually, and allow for the County to begin the process of billing commercial insurances (non Medicaid) for Crisis responses; and
31 32 33	<b>WHEREAS</b> , additionally, there will be the creation of a Mobile Response Crisis Superviso position – Exempt 060; and
34 35	WHEREAS, this position will supervise the 24-hour Mobile Response operation; and
36 37	WHEREAS, it is anticipated that this position will be budget neutral due to increased Medicaid billing.
