6	WHEREAS, Jason Visor has filed a claim with the Racine County Clerk's Office on
7	January 26, 2018 in the amount of \$8,738.79 for property damage to his 1998 Cadillac that
8	was secured in the Racine County Sheriff's Office's secure evidence lot pursuant to his
9	arrest on December 21, 2014;

11	WHEREAS, Jason Visor's vehicle was released to his father, Tony Visor, on April
12	21, 2015; and

14	WHEREAS, Jason Visor was released from custody on May 23, 2017; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, Jason Visor's claim is not timely as he did not file his notice of
17	circumstances with the Racine County Clerk within 120 days of the incident; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, the Corporation Counsel and the Racine County Sheriff's Office have
20	investigated this claim and recommend denial based on the investigation which concluded
21	that the claim did not follow required statutory procedures and that the claim for damages
22	made by Mr. Visor was not substantiated.
