17 **WHEREAS**, Racine County has been notified that it is eligible for grant funds from
18 the Wisconsin Department of Justice NCS-X Incident Reporting Grant in the amount of
19 \$7,500.00; and

21 **WHEREAS**, this grant funding supports the implementation of the Wisconsin Based
22 Incident Reporting System (WIBRS) which is an incident based reporting system used by
23 law enforcement agencies in Wisconsin for collecting and reporting data on crimes and
24 arrests; and

26 **WHEREAS**, funds are being directed to the implementation of the system to collect
27 and submit data in support of the FBI Uniform Crime Reporting program; and

29 **WHEREAS**, more specifically, grant funding awarded to Racine County will be
30 utilized to offset \$7,500.00 in upgrade costs to the Phoenix Data Management System
31 which is currently utilized county wide as the sole data management application in public
32 safety; and

34 **WHEREAS**, the modification is necessary to allow the system to compile crime data
35 in compliance with WIBRS protocols.
