WHEREAS, there is a need to hire a qualified county electrician; and

WHEREAS, the current per hour pay scale for the county electrician is a range of \$28.26 to \$30.13 but the county has been unable to find qualified individuals with the knowledge, skills, and licensing required to fill that position at that pay rate; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the comparable positions within both the public and private sectors, online searches of similar positions that remain unfilled within the external market, an adjustment is warranted to attract and retain qualified individuals; and

WHEREAS, Buildings and Facilities Management is requesting that the per hour pay scale be adjusted from its present range to a new range of \$32.25 to \$35.25 per hour, which is more suited to retain qualified individuals.
