Outpatient Mental Health Neurologist

Provide neurological examinations

- Provide assessment and document bio-psycho-social intake.
- Administer neurological exam. The exam includes tests to assess mental status, function of the cranial nerves (including vision), strength, coordination, reflexes, and sensation.
- Provide determinations of the localization of the pathology.
- Develop differential diagnosis and refer for further medical tests if necessary, confirm a diagnosis and ultimately guide therapy and appropriate management.

Purchaser agrees that provider will bill one third (1/3) of hours provided at the neurology rate and two thirds (2/3) of the hours provided at the psychology rate for the duration of this contract.

Must be licensed in Wisconsin as Psychologist and a Neurologist, and be able to practice without restriction. Must be have professional liability insurance \$1/\$3 million coverage Must pass Wisconsin criminal and caregiver background check
