Psychiatrist

The Provider will serve as the Psychiatrist for Behavioral Health Services of Racine County on a part-time consulting basis and meet the qualifications specified under Wisconsin Statute HFS 75/35 and be licensed under chapter 448 to practice medicine. In addition, the Psychiatrist will perform an initial assessment and ongoing medication management.

Provider shall perform duties in accordance with standard psychiatrist practices.

Must be licensed in Wisconsin as Psychiatrist, and be able to practice without restriction.

Must be have professional liability insurance \$1/\$3 million coverage

Must pass Wisconsin criminal and caregiver background check

Must have a professional experience or desire to provide services to the uninsured and underinsured.
