BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the 2018 Racine County Budget as set forth in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto is authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the 2018 Racine County Budget which is incorporated herein by reference be and is hereby adopted. A copy of the 2018 Racine County Executive Budget shall be on file with the Racine County Clerk and available online at RacineCounty.com.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the capital projects as set forth in "CAPITAL PROJECTS" page 39-2 and pages 43-45 through 43-52 of the Racine County 2018 Budget are hereby authorized and approved provided that, any projects that are to be funded through the proceeds of a bond sale are contingent on the County Board authorizing the appropriate bond sale through the passage of appropriate authorizing resolution. The capital projects that are approved in this budget are non-lapsing capital projects and shall continue from year to year until completed or until unauthorized by the Racine County Board of Supervisors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the added positions, eliminated positions, and reclassifications as shown in pages 43-3 through 43-21 of the Racine County 2018 Budget are authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the fees set forth on pages 43-27 through 43-44 of the Racine County 2018 Budget are authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the non-lapsing and/or revenue transfer accounts set forth on pages 43-23 through 43-26 of the Racine County 2018 budget are authorized and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County budget is adopted by the Racine County Board of Supervisors at the level stated on the Authorized Budget page.

The Levels of control on the Authorized Budget Page are:

Capital Projects – The level of control on the Authorized Budget Page are at the organization level.

Transfers between any of the specified budget level of control may be made by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to Sec. 2-86 Racine County Code of Ordinances or by the Finance and Human Resources Committee pursuant to Sec. 2-130 Racine County Code of Ordinances.

For purposes of the annual financial report the General Fund and the Human Services fund budgets are adopted at the function level and all other funds are adopted at the total fund level.

The Racine County Budget also contains the Budget Detail Supplemental page, which is the detail supporting the Authorized Budget Page and is intended only to be supplemental information and not adopted by the Racine County Board of Supervisors. The Finance Director is authorized to establish the accounts as set forth in the Budget Detail Supplemental page. Transfers are allowed between the accounts established by the Finance Director and the County Executive. A report on all such transfers shall be submitted to the Racine County Finance and Human Resources Committee by the Finance Department on a quarterly basis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Finance Director is authorized to make any technical corrections in the budget that are deemed necessary.

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-107

ORDINANCE BY THE FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AMENDING THE RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES - CHAPTER 2 ARTICLE V DIVISION 2 - DEPARTMENTS FOR CHANGES IN THE 2014 BUDGET

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

Part 1

Section 2-266 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to departments is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-266, - Created.

The following departments are created for Racine County and shall be under the direction and supervision of their respective department heads who shall be under the direction and supervision of the county executive:

(1) The finance department which shall include the office of auditor, the purchasing division and the mail room/print shop printing and services division.

(2) The human resources department.

 (3) The information systems department.

(4) The corporation counsel's office which shall include the office of Child Support Enforcement.
 (5) The public works and development services department which shall include

 (5) The public works and development services department which shall include the parks division, the building and facilities division, the highway division, the development services division, the land conservation division and the land information division.
 (6) The human services department which shall include a youth and family

division, an adult services division, an economic support division, an operations division, workforce development division, a fiscal division, the Ridgewood Care Center, a veteran's service office, behavioral health service and UW extension.

 (7) The community services department which shall include the emergency management office and the medical examiner's office.
 (8) The communications department.

Part 2

Section 2-267 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to Elected Officials is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-267. - Elected Officials.

The following departments are created which shall be under the control and supervision of the indicated elected constitutional officer and shall have such powers, duties and functions as set forth in this division and in the laws of the State of Wisconsin:

(1) The county treasurer's office which shall be under the control of the county treasurer.

(2) The county clerk's office which shall be under the control of the county clerk.

 (3) The register of deed's/land description office which shall be under the control of the register of deeds and shall include the real property lister office.

(4) The clerk of court office which shall be under the control of the clerk of circuit court.

 (5) The district attorney's office which shall be under the control of the district attorney and which shall include the victim/witness office.

 (6) The sheriff's department office which shall be under the control of the sheriff.

Part 3

Section 2-272 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to finance is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-272. - Finance.

There shall be a finance department. Its duties shall include providing assistance in the preparation of the annual budget, monitoring and controlling the day-to-day financial operations of the county, and analyzing the potential impact of county policies and initiatives. The finance director shall be the head of the finance department. The finance director shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by the board of supervisors. The finance director shall also be the auditor for Racine County. Additional powers, duties and functions of the auditor are set forth in section 2-286 of this chapter. The finance director shall also be the director of purchasing and shall be in charge of the purchasing division. The duties of the purchasing division (previously the purchasing department) and the director of purchasing are set forth in chapter 7 of this code. The finance director will be in charge of the mail room/print shop print and services division.
